



CAT.B. 117-2013 / CA SENATE BILL 1019



Due to recent modifications of California Technical Bulletin 117-2013 as well as California Senate Bill 1019, flame retardants have recently become a point of interest within the State of California for the seating industry.

The scope of this legislation requires furniture manufacturers to inform the public if any components utilized contain added flame retardant chemicals. Most all seating for sale within the state of California must be labeled indicating conformance or non-conformance to CA Tech Bulletin 117-2013 (if not compliant with other California seating performance requirements). CATB 117-2013 / CA Senate Bill 1019 requires specific labeling to identify if the furniture contains added flame retardants.

All Spradling International's vinyl and PU-coated fabrics contain flame retardant additives.
