

# VINYL COMPARISON

## EXPANDED VS. NON-WOVEN

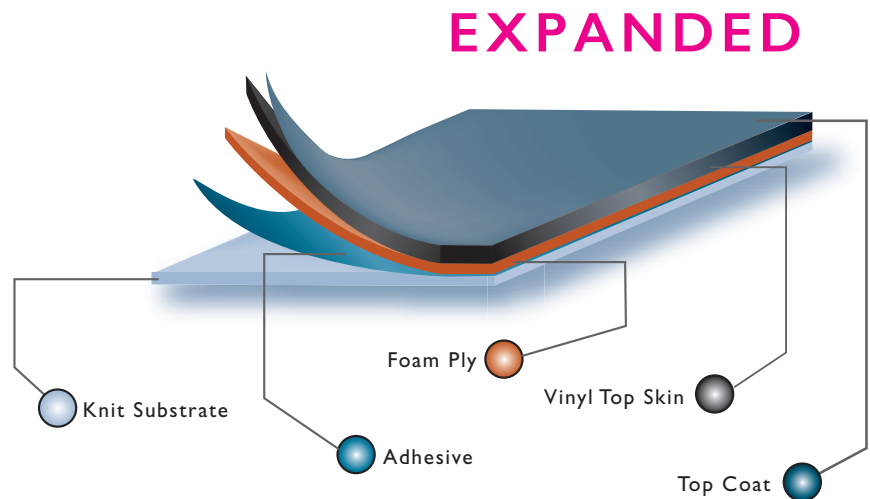


### DESCRIPTION

Polyvinyl Chloride expanded foam ply with a vinyl film top skin, generally applied to a 100% polyester knit backing.

### CHARACTERISTICS

- One-way stretch
- Faster recovery
- Lends itself to sharper, tailored lines

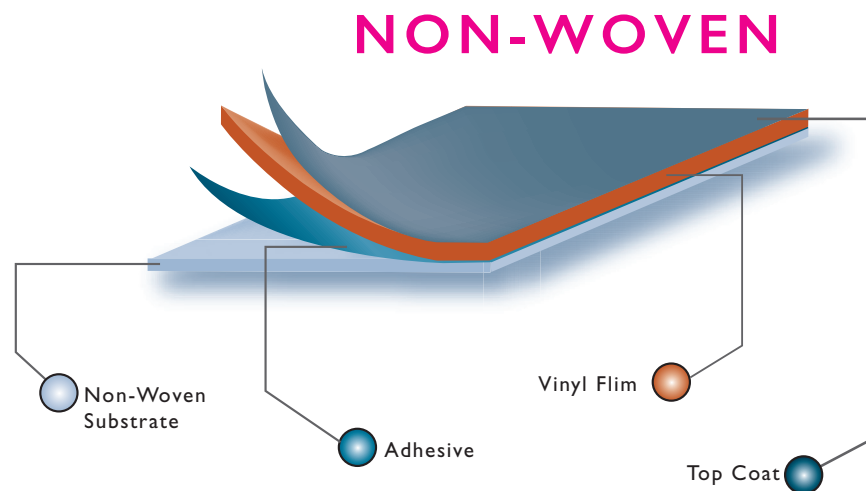


### DESCRIPTION

Polyvinyl film top coat and laminated or extruded upon a needle punch substrate.

### CHARACTERISTICS

- Two-way stretch
- Slower recovery
- Lends itself to softer, cushioned look



## SUMMARY

Note: The primary difference between the expanded and the non-woven is the construction and the thickness of the vinyl film.

#1. There is no correlation to quality of upholstery vinyl to weight

#2. There is no correlation to quality of upholstery vinyl to thickness
